

This guide highlights a selection of land and sea tours for guests of Amarela, offering relaxed and meaningful ways to explore Bohol's countryside, heritage sites, and marine sanctuaries.

ANDA TOUR

A scenic journey to the eastern coast of Bohol, best suited for guests seeking natural landscapes and quieter destinations.

Highlights include Anda Beach, Cabugnaw Cave Pool, Can-umantad Falls and Candijay Rice Terraces.

Guests who wish to include Alicia Panoramic Park may do so for an additional PHP 1,500, payable directly to the driver.

COUNTRYSIDE TOUR

A comprehensive introduction to Bohol's most iconic inland attractions and cultural landmarks. Stops may include the Corella Tarsier Sanctuary, Blood Compact Monument, Baclayon Church, Loboc River Cruise, Man-Made Forest, Bilar Eco Park, Sevilla Hanging Bridge, and the Chocolate Hills.

Optional activities such as ATV or buggy rides at Chocolate Hills Adventure Park (CHAP) are available at an additional cost.

Guests who wish to avail of all optional activities may do so with corresponding charges, payable directly to the driver.

PANGLAO TOUR

An easy-paced exploration of Panglao Island's local highlights, which may include Hinagdanan Cave, the Shell Museum, Alona Beach, and Bohol Bee Farm. A relaxed option ideal for shorter travel times and coastal sightseeing.

FIREFLY TOUR

An evening river experience in Loay or Maribojoc, where guests observe fireflies in their natural habitat. This gentle, nature-based activity is conducted with local guides and is best enjoyed after sunset.

DANAO TOUR

A focused inland experience centered on Danao Adventure Park, known for its adventure activities and dramatic river gorge setting. Ideal for guests seeking a more active day.

ALICIA PARK TOUR

DOLPHIN WATCHING

An early morning boat excursion offering the chance to observe dolphins in their natural habitat as they swim freely in open waters. This experience is conducted responsibly and with respect for marine life, making it a peaceful and memorable way to begin the day at sea.

ISLAND SNORKELING

A guided snorkeling experience in protected marine sanctuaries of Balicasag Island or Pamilacan Island. Both are known for clear waters, vibrant corals, and abundant marine life. Balicasag Island includes two designated sites: Turtle Watching and the Fish Sanctuary. Pamilacan Island may include three sites: Coral Garden, Turtle Watching, and the Fish Sanctuary.

Please note that environmental user fees (EUF) and local guide fees apply and are collected on-site. These fees support marine conservation efforts and local communities.

- Balicasag Island: PHP 300 per person per site (2 sites)
- Pamilacan Island: PHP 300 per person per site (3 sites)

DOLPHIN WATCHING & ISLAND SNORKELING

A combined sea experience that begins with dolphin watching in open waters, followed by guided snorkeling at Balicasag Island. This option offers a well-rounded marine adventure, blending wildlife observation with time exploring coral reefs and fish sanctuaries.

For the Balicasag portion of the tour, environmental user fees and local guide fees apply, covering two sites: Turtle Watching and the Fish Sanctuary. Fees are paid on-site and contribute to the protection of the marine environment.
